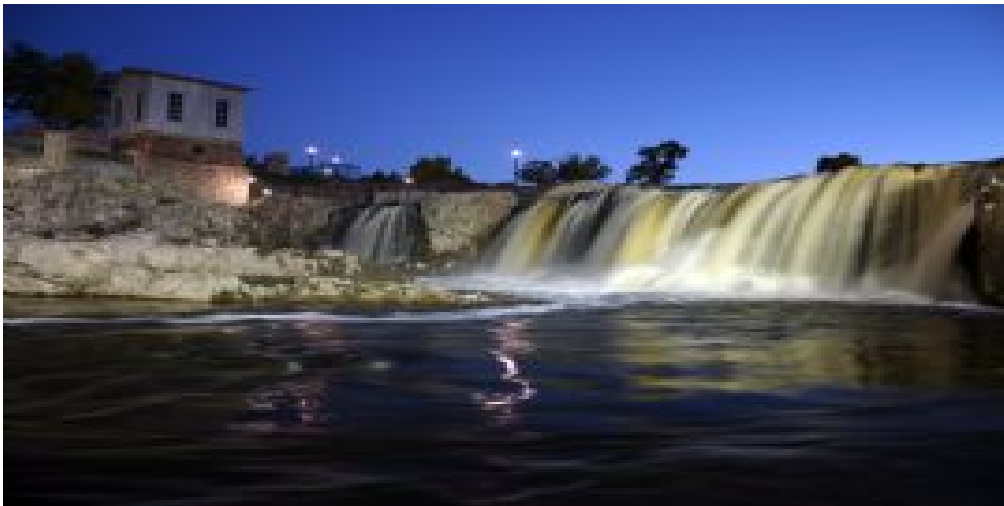

Baseball Facilities

Harmodon Baseball Complex

All Legion and VFW tournaments will be held at Harmodon Baseball Complex which opened in 2005. The Harmodon Complex ranks as one of the premier baseball complexes in the upper Midwest. The facility features seven MUSCO lighted fields with grass infields with age specific playing dimensions for American Legion and VFW age participants. The complex features six batting cages and two concession stands, an agri-lime practice field and two Championship level fields for Legion and 13/14 VFW Age participants.

Pasley Baseball Complex

The Pasley Complex, which opened 2003, features seven agri-lime fields with astro-mounds. The complex also features three batting cages, a full service concession stand, playground facilities and a picnic shelter for participants and their families.

The Mid-Summer Legion Division offers a championship format tournament with a capacity of 8 teams or two pools of four. Teams may play 3 or 4 games depending on tournament format. All games are 9 innings with no time limit. In event of weather, 5 innings will constitute a game. Mercy rule of 15 runs after 5 innings, 12 runs after 6 innings, or 10 runs after 7 innings.

The VFW Division 15/16 Division offers a championship format tournament with a capacity of 8 teams or two pools of four. All games are scheduled for 7 innings with an 8-run rule after 5 innings or 15 runs after 3 innings.

The VFW 13 & 14-year-old tournament offers a championship format tournament with a capacity of 12 teams or 3 pools of four. During the first two days of the tournament, no new inning will be allowed to begin once a game has reached a time of 2 hours unless the game is tied. Mercy rules of 8-run rule after 5 innings or 15 runs after 3 innings will be utilized
